In presence of India's one of the finest academic and researcher, Prof. Saranjit Singh's on the auspicious eve of Teacher's Day; undergraduate, post graduate pharmacy students, research

scholars along with staff and faculty members of SPTM Shirpur celebrated this event on Sept 05, 2020.

A great orator and trainer that Prof. Singh is; shared insights on various exciting career options for budding pharma-professionals through this webinar. His talk was divided in 3 segments each focusing on different aspects to professional development. During his talk Prof. Singh shared his views on 'Inspired Career'. In order to explain the 'in depth' meaning of this term he stressed on exploring all possible career avenues, sorting 'routine' vs 'exclusive' vs 'futuristic' job categories & further to hone one's skills, put all efforts to achieve the goal.

Further, he discussed several examples of corporate world and upcoming technologies like AI, Modelling and Simulation and Big Data Analytics -that would turn the way pharma industry will work in next decade. He highlighted the future job scenario in India and further stated how pharmacy students can leverage this opportunity- as 'job seekers'.

In his last segment of the talk- he shared success stories of his students at NIPER as real life examples. The most notable among these examples was the success story of a start-up - StanPlus - founded by his own son- Mr. Prabhdeep Singh- who incidentally is an alumnus of SPP SPTM, Mumbai campus!

He concluded his talk by urging all the youngsters to 'Stand Tall' to make India a new Super power in near future. Prof. Singh answered the questions of the students and faculty members. The session concluded with vote of thanks- with special gratitude to Prof. Singh, recognizing his contribution in the field of Pharmacy.

**HOW TO START A START-UP** by Anna Vital

The infographic outlines the following steps:

- live in the future, ahead of your time**
- what is missing in the world?**
- write it down and bounce ideas around**
- make a prototype**
- show the prototype to 100 people**
- launch** - let everyone know you have made something
- iterate on the prototype** - sell it, make sense
- follow up with users** - Are they coming back?
- launch again** (after iterating) - launch until users stop (Airbnb launched 3 times)
- 1,000 users** - get to 1,000 users (if they are a growing business)
- grow 5% a week** (hard, but grows possible)
- keep growing** for another 4 years, and at that rate you will reach 20 million users
- SUCCESS**


